## A BILL

  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF IMPORTS OF
4 BEEF AND BEEF PRODUCTS FROM PARA5 GUAY.

Beef and beef products imported from Paraguay may
not enter the United States during the period—

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(1) beginning on the date of the enactment of
 this Act; and

3 (2) ending on the date on which the working 4 group established under section 2 submits the rec-5 ommendations required by subsection (a)(3) of that 6 section if the working group determines under sub-7 section (a)(1) of that section that beef and beef 8 products imported from Paraguay do not pose a 9 threat to food safety and animal health in the 10 United States.

## 11 SEC. 2. WORKING GROUP ON BEEF IMPORTED FROM PARA12 GUAY.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days after the
date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall establish a working group—

16 (1) to evaluate the threat posed by beef and
17 beef products imported from Paraguay to food safe18 ty and animal health in the United States;

19 (2) to report on the most recent disease data
20 and conduct additional research on the threat to
21 food safety and animal health; and

(3) to make recommendations to the Secretary
with respect to whether the importation of beef and
beef products from Paraguay into the United States
should be permitted.

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(b) MEMBERSHIP.—The Secretary shall ensure that
 the working group established under subsection (a) in cludes—

4 (1) experts on food safety;

5 (2) experts on animal health; and

6 (3) representatives of U.S. Customs and Border
7 Protection and other Federal agencies with respon8 sibilities relating to international trade.
